

FILING DEADLINES FOR FLORIDA BEVERAGE MANUFACTURERS

Florida alcoholic beverage manufacturers are obligated to comply with periodic filing and reporting deadlines at the federal, state, and municipal levels of government. The following table summarizes the most common of these filing deadlines. This is not a comprehensive list, and different or additional filing requirements may apply.
